Curling signup on Tuesday, Sept. 12

Registration for the 2017-18 curling season will be held Tuesday, Sept. 12 at 7 p.m. at the club.

There will be no changes to the regular curling leagues, Meyers Board Chair Ken McCulloch said during the AGM meeting last week.

As well, Ken announced that fees will not be raised this year. Adult membership remains a bargain at \$398.30, or \$38 a month, which includes the curling season and year-round use of the fitness facility. Student memberships are \$186.40 annually or \$18 monthly.

During the annual meeting, it was decided to offer a three-month membership for \$210 on a trial basis this year. The three-month membership includes full use of the club facilities for that period.

During registration, there will also be a chance to sign up for curling lessons. Timing of the lessons and details are being worked out and will depend on your interest.
