Rink renos add wood and colour





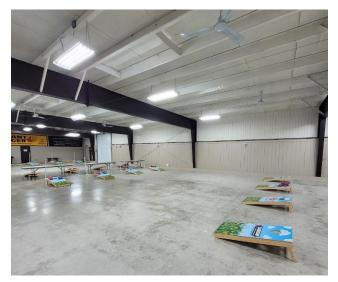
Volunteer painters and carpenters making major improvements to our club.
