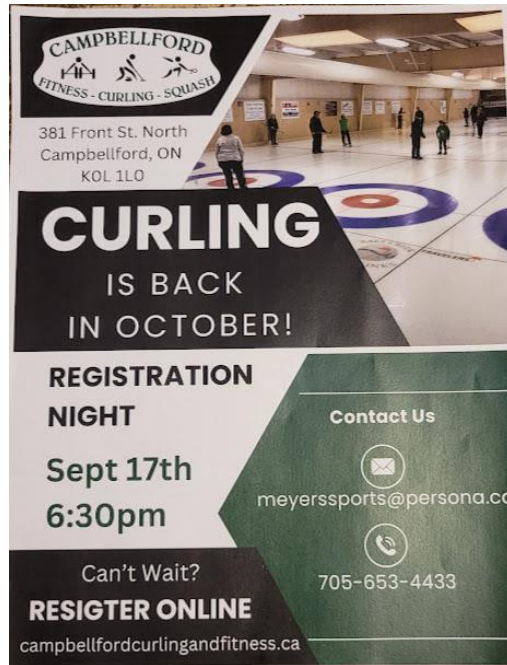


Marketing campaign needs your help, well, actually just your lawn space
